



John A. McGrath MD FRCP FMedSci

John McGrath is the academic head of St John's Institute of Dermatology in London where he also runs the Genetic Skin Disease Group. He grew up in Japan, Australia and the U.K. He qualified in medicine at Guy's Hospital in London in 1985 and then trained in dermatology and dermatopathology at St John's Institute of Dermatology. He then also undertook his doctoral thesis on ultrastructural skin biology at St John's before heading to Philadelphia for post-doctoral studies in molecular genetics. He was appointed full Professor at King's College London in 2000. He now holds the Mary Dunhill Chair in Cutaneous Medicine at King's College London and is Honorary Consultant Dermatologist to the Guy's and St Thomas' National Health Service Foundation Trust. He has lead roles in delivering experimental medicine and precision medicine within the Biomedical Research Centre at Guy's Hospital and in organising several national phenotyping and genotyping of rare disease initiatives in the U.K. His research focuses on the molecular characterization of inherited skin diseases and the development of novel treatments for rare skin diseases.
